New Mileage Reimbursement Procedure

Attention Drivers: Beginning April 1, 2009 we at ECHHO will be required to document all driving assignments on a monthly basis. In order to continue to receive mileage reimbursement funding from the Olympic Area Agency of Aging, our drivers and clients will be required to sign a form confirming the details of the drive.

How it works: The ECHHO office will mail a Mileage Reimbursement form and return envelope to the driver when an assignment is made. At the end of the trip, the driver will fill in the time and mileage. The driver and the client will sign the form. The driver will keep the form until month's end and add any additional trips. At the end of the month, the driver can then either mail the form back to us or drop it off at the ECHHO office.

We hope to make this paperwork as painless as possible, as it would be painful indeed to lose our funding for mileage reimbursement! Thanks to all of our dedicated drivers for your continued patience and cooperation.

Vacationing volunteer drivers – a request from the ECHHO staff: Please call us when you will be traveling and let us know the dates when you will be unavailable. It will help tremendously, and you will come home to fewer messages on your telephone. Please leave a detailed message on our phone if you notify us after office hours. Thank you!
